




ON THE BUS TO BUSIA COUNTY

On the Morning of January 1st , I was helped together with my luggage by my colleague Andrew Chonge to the Guardian Bus terminus very early at 6am to travel to Busia county. I embarked on this new phase of restarting this school training and empowering youth project again. But 2Km at city stadium in Nairobi his vehicle broke down and it was pushed to the terminus only to be stuck at KPCU hill about 100meters to the terminus and so he called me and I went to pick the luggage with a mukokoteni Cat/trolley man.







BADLY HIT FOR THE THIRD TIME BY MALARIA:-

By the end of the second week, I was badly hit for the third time in three months, in Mombasa, Nairobi and now in Busia, with yet another serious fever and I got very scared even to go to the clinic, because I was new to the area, and so because I was a stranger in this place, I did not want them to associate this fever with Corona, since Corona happens to be the new song that is now being associated with every illness. And so for over two weeks I tried to keep of the streets and I guarantined my self indoors.

However I could not hide it because I became more ill and so I went to the Royal Community Medical clinic. With luck the Doc at the Medical clinic took blood samples and finally identified the root course. I had serious Malaria.

So I got a 3X Jabs in three days and antimalarial-pills. These pills are a nightmare to bare, for they hit-up your body and you go into a frenzy of unbearable dreams and you sweat almsat 1 half a litter of sweat.







GOT WATER ETCHING BLISTERS:-

In between this saga, I went to a the neighboring village researching and it was very hot that day. (we are at 0-degrees at the equator at this place and so its almost hot everyday). I drank a glass of un-boiled water from a good Samaritan and for two weeks I started getting water blisters and for the first time in my life. I have drunk dirtier water and I got away with it but this time, I was nailed and so I got a reaction from this stream water and that is not all. These blisters etch and you feel like scratching them to the borne. So irritating was this experience.

GRAND MOTHER IS HIT BY MALARIA:-

By the time I was getting better, my Grandmother who was also hit by malaria was also fighting for her life. In early December last year 2020, I said goodbye to her in Mombasa and I told her that I was heading to Busia via Nairobi to restart the school project.





SHE PLANNED TO GO BACK TO HER HOUSE She told me that she was also planning to go back to her home in Luanda-Bunyore, near Maseno, before Christmas. And so we wished each other well and off I went. Because the journey from Mombasa is far, takes over 13 hours by bus and would be a back breaking one for a 100 year old lady, my Aunt got he an air ticket from Mombasa-Airport to Kisumu-Airport and there after 45 minutes by taxi to her house, which took less that 1/2 of the time by bus. So in 5 hours she was drinking tea at her home.

GRAND MOTHER IS RESTED:-

But two weeks later, she got a serious Malaria. But because Grandmother had sugar, HBP and other controllable complications, everyone concentrated on her usual complications, while malaria which was discovered late, was eating her guts out. Unfortunately she rested on the morning of the 4th-02-2021 and we buried her on 19th/Feb/2021 in Vihiga County. My grandmother had 12-kids of her own, 36 grand-children, 74X-greatgrand kids and 5X great-great grand kids. Grandmother Elipha Omari Otinga, sunrise 1918 and sunset 2021. RIP.

I have been given several tips and have been shown several possible places to lease/rent and possibly to buy, but I am yet to meet the landlords to hear what they have to offer us. One of the properties is 15 meters just next to high-way. It is an attractive offer, but we are yet to talk. We will seriously consider to see and compare several things to why we can/should place our school project there in a particular piece of land.







TOUGH YEAR BUT STILL GOING STRONG, POSITIVE AND MOVING ON:-

So for me its been a tough and heavy starting period of this year, but I will not give up. Sickness has put me down thrice in 3months and the death of my grandmother, But I am up again, positive, still strong, gaining my strength to keep on moving until the objective is fully achieved.



As long as I am breathing and I am able to stand, walk and work and you give me support, I will never give up until the objective of this project are full accomplished. I will continuously focus on the success of this project no matter how many times I will fall I will wake up wipe off the mud and move on and keep moving. That is a promise you can take to the bank.
