Together Pastor Silvester Namwamba, one of our colleague board members, we talked, explained, discussed and we gave Monique and Richard the demands, needs and requirements from NITA the government inspection office on a blue paper, as seen in our previous Newsletter. We discussed the progress and the challenges and the urgent needs of the school. These are the requirements that we must fulfill before the next inspection.



This previous inspection was in March 2026, although we booked for it, we were not ready. NITA does at least 5 inspections per year throughout the country. Although the requirements are similar with (TVETA), these are not as strict.
